

Astrid Twidale, mother of our late resident Fiona who passed away in July, arranged a short memorial service at Casa Caritas on Tuesday 14 September 2021.


Minister Theo Van Rensburg conducted the service, which was well attended by staff members. Some of them gave up their rest days to come into work to pay their last respects.

## Heritage Day 2021

Heritage Day is an opportunity for everyone in South Africa to celebrate their cultural heritage in a meaningful way. The population of South Africa is one of the most complex and diverse in the world. We are often simply classified as Black, White, Coloured and Asian, but the real picture is much more colourful.

The black population of South Africa is divided into four major ethnic groups; namely Nguni (Zulu, Xhosa, Ndebele and Swazi), Sotho, Shangaan-Tsonga and Venda. There are numerous subgroups within these, of which the Zulu and Xhosa (two subgroups of the Nguni group) are the largest. About 60% of the white population is of Afrikaans descent, with many of the remaining 40% being of British or European descent. The coloured population have a mixed lineage, which often comprises the indigenous Khoisan genes combined with African slaves that were brought here from all over the continent, and white settlers. birthplace in East Africa to the Cape. Most of the Asian population are of Indian descent.

There are eleven official languages in South Africa: These are Sepedi, Sesotho, Setswana, siSwati, Tshivenda, Xitsonga, Afrikaans, English, isiNdebele, isiXhosa and isiZulu. Of course, many other languages from all over the world are spoken here too; including German, Dutch, Portuguese, Greek, Italian, Spanish, French, Chinese, etc.
