

# Donations wish list




### Fire damage update

Although the fire department has not yet issued us with their final report, we can safely assume that the fire in our garage last month was caused by an old faulty geyser. Electricians have been on site to check our electrical installation and they didn't find any further red flags. The insurance company has approved our claim and reparations are underway.

Operations Assistant Natanya's daughter Carli captured the picture on the right in the garage during the clean-up.
