We would also like to introduce water therapy in the courtyard during the hot summer days and for that we need an Intex plastic swimming pool.

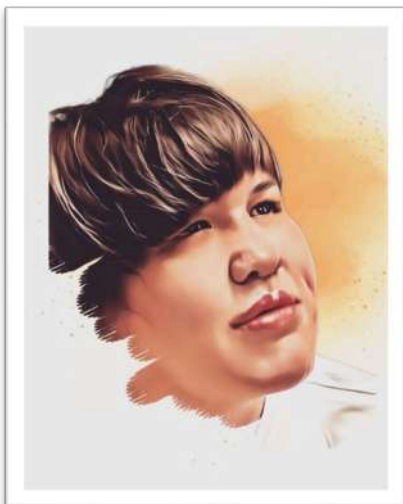
VACANT ROOMS AT CASA CARITAS 24/7 CARE
